For decades Gallup has tracked churches, for the first time, more adults in the U.S. do not attend church than do. That's not to say Christianity is shrinking - parts of our world are experiencing astronomical growth.

So, why is Gloria Dei doing well? I could mention 25 factors (including visibility, not our coffee), but I want to focus on 3, which I believe are critical to remember and celebrate:

- 1. CENTRAL. Think of primary importance That's faith in Jesus and celebrating God's grace. The Sacraments. Bible study. Prayer. Service to those in need. Fellowship. Grace changes everything! Like a central train station, from this point, you can go in all sorts of directions, which leads to...
- 2. CREATIVE. No one likes change, but the right changes, tweaks are critical. All this is food for thought. I pray you have a blessed, restful, and renewing summer.



I can't believe this is the middle of summer! Talk about *Citius, Altius, Fortius* (Faster, Higher, Stronger)! Each week seems like it is going *faster.* Last month was VBS and what a fast paced week. I felt so honored to share a bible story with over fifty children that attended those five days. The bar was set *higher* for me as I prepared a different ten minute bible story with lots of animation and props. I was so grateful to Emma Person and Jenna Hallowell who were my assistants for those five days. We built altars, made a great fish, weathered a storm, built an empty tomb, and made a purple prayer wall. We all embraced our *stronger* imagination as we traveled back in time to learn about Jesus' love, friendship, and praying.

St Paul tells us to "pray without ceasing" (Thessalonians 5:17). Praying will definitely makes us *stronger*. In the next couple of months we will introduce a new prayer ministry after Sunday services. If you have any concerns, needs, or gratitudes I'll be standing near the candle station after each service. I would be honored to pray with you and for you. As this ministry grows, I look forward to many of you joining me as prayer partners for others.

Praying helps us to communicate with our *higher* source-God. In September, make plans to join us for a Labyrinth Walk through our beautiful desert courtyard. It has been a few years since our last Prayer Labyrinth. We will have a bulletin with seven scriptures and seven prayers printed out for you. One for each of the seven stations in the courtyard to stop at and pray. Labyrinths are found in many cultures dating back 3,500 years. Medieval Christians walked and prayed instead of taking a hazardous pilgrimage to Jerusalem. The object was to walk in the footsteps of Christ. Praying makes us *stronger*.

Speaking of *stronger*, we are a strong church with many members who are over ninety years young. Join us for a special birthday party in August to honor these wonderful nonagenarians (90-99) and centenarians (100-109). They have such a rich history of life lessons from which we can all learn something.

Future projects for me will be researching grief groups, healing services, involvement with the Church year services, and anything else the Holy Spirit leads me to. I am grateful to be serving and praying for you.
