All three services will be with candlelight, special instrumental music, choirs, and more. (The Sacrament of Holy Communion will be celebrated at the 10pm service.)


We carry on, we sing loudly, we smile at our neighbors, we help, we shake the hands of everyone near, we visit the shut-in, we pray, and we don't give up, because:
