Dear Gloria Dei family,

The Season of Lent is the Christian preparation for Easter. We follow Jesus to the cross and on to the empty tomb. That's hope!

The Season of Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, March 5. This is a day of repentance, reflection, and the beginning of this wondrous journey. At Gloria Dei, we have the traditional "*Imposition of Ashes*" - an outward sign of our inward desire to receive the forgiveness and grace of Jesus. There will be 3 opportunities to receive ashes: 1) A Drive-by (brief prayer, scripture, blessing) in the upper circle between 8am-9am. 2) Noon worship in the Sanctuary. 3) Worship in Bankson Hall at 7pm with a soup supper beginning at 6pm.

This year, the theme of our Lenten pilgrimage will be *WHERE GRACE IS SERVED* (Meeting Jesus at the Table). Each Wednesday, a different member will share their personal faith story and the connection between their walk of faith and a memorable meal or hospitality.

We will also take a special offering through Lent (Offering coin boxes will be available at the Welcome Table) and this will be divided between Lutheran Disaster Response and World Central Kitchen. We also hope to pair up with a congregation in Altadena or another area impacted by wildfires.

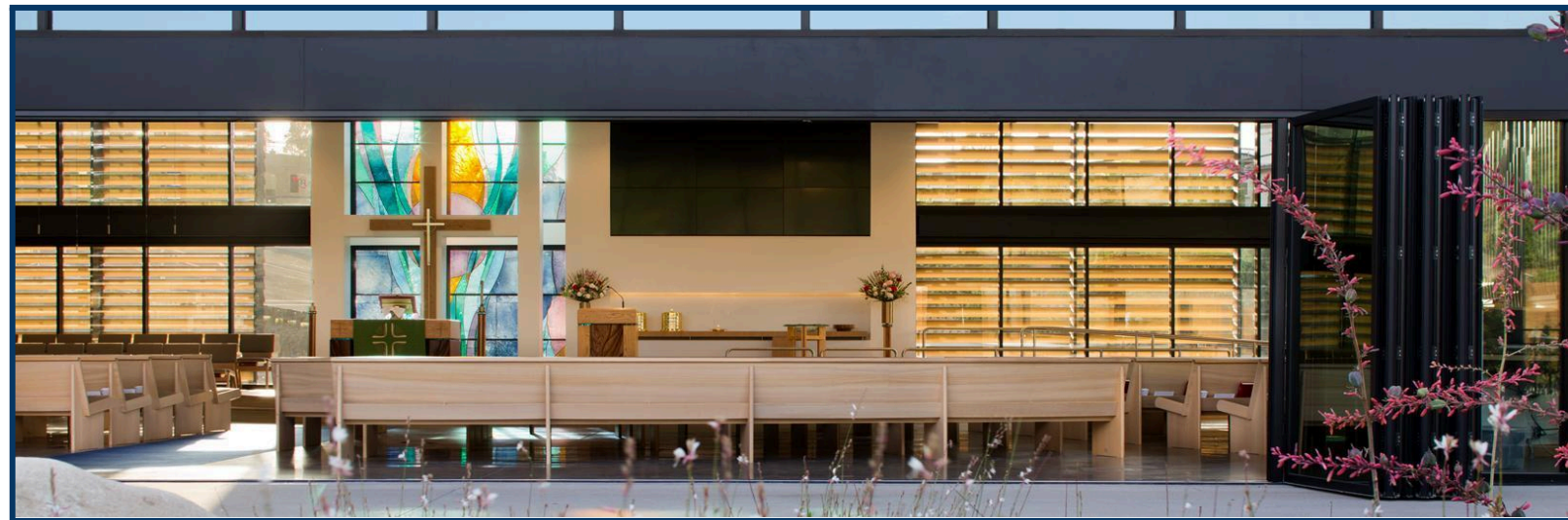
**SHELLI PARAJECKAS, PRESCHOOL DIRECTOR****PRESCHOOL**

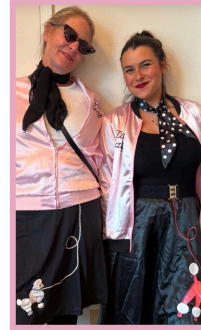

2025 dates at the Orphanage are:

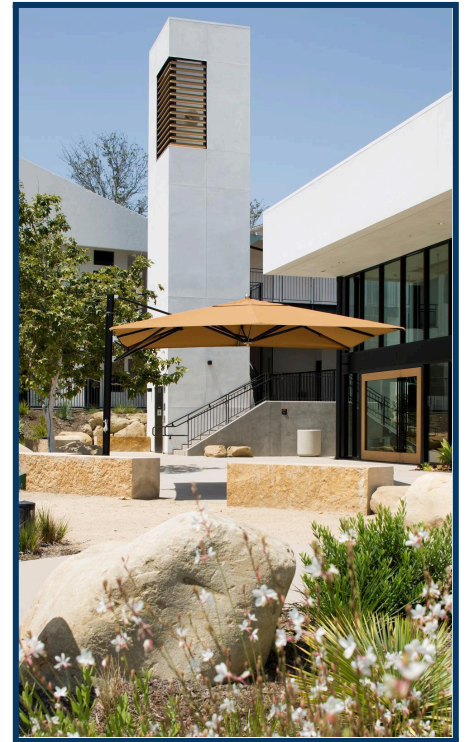

The van(s) leave Gloria Dei at 7am & return the same day about 7pm. A passport is required for this trip. Bring your own water & snacks for the ride down & back.



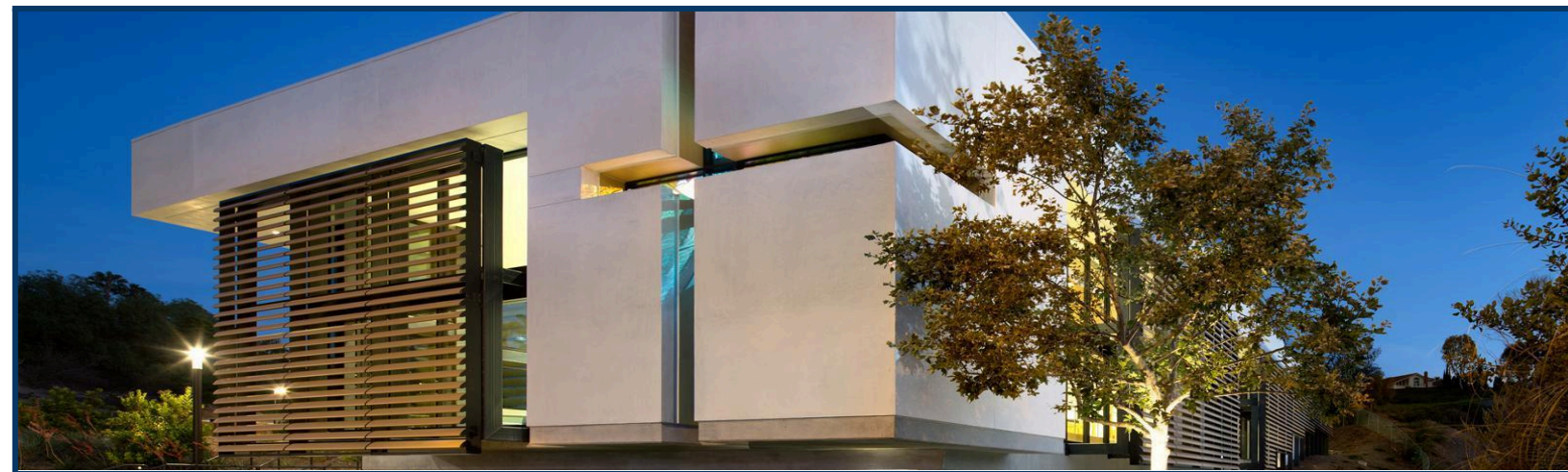

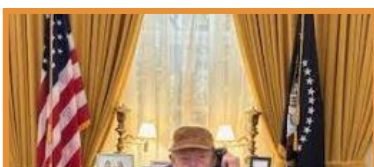
